More about raptors

RAPTORS rule the skies. With exceptional vision, they can spot prey from miles away. Their wings are powerful, their feet strong and their talons and hooked beaks have awed many.

This month, these migratory birds of prey will be making their way back to breeding grounds in the northern hemisphere, with a quick pit stop in Tanjung Tuan, Malacca.

Raptors have been stopping over in Tanjung Tuan for thousands of years.

The area offers them ample food and adequate shelter during their journeys.

Tanjung Tuan is the only remaining patch of coastal forest on the west coast of the peninsula with rich coral life and sea grass

that attracts fish and turtles.

Raptor Watch 2009, organised by the Malaysian Nature Society, hopes to raise awareness on the conservation of raptors and their habitats.

It will be held on March 14-15 between 10am and 5pm at the PNB Ilham Resort, Tanjung Tuan.
